To Book A Presentation You Need

A minimum of 40 children for the presentation, a hall or gymnasium with a projection screen (or a clean surface suitable to project a video) and an accessible electrical outlet.

How To Book Your Presentation

Contact the BC Sports Hall of Fame and provide details about your group (preferred dates/times, age and size of the group, etc.). The Hall of Fame will arrange for an Inductee, also known as an Honoured Member, to participate in the Hero In You presentation at no cost to you. The Hall of Fame facilitator will let you know which Honoured Member will present once your booking has been confirmed.

Before Your Presentation

Visit the Hero In You website (heroinyou.ca) to see lesson plans, photographs, and information about Hall of Fame Inductees. Short biographies are available on the BC Sports Hall of Fame's website at bcsportshall.com. Please consider sharing these with your students.

Day of the Presentation (presentation is approximately 1 hour in total)

A Hall of Fame facilitator will arrive 30 minutes before the presentation to set-up. If possible, please provide a parking space close to the entrance of the school to unload artifacts and equipment. The Hall of Fame facilitator will deliver a 10-minute talk to introduce the Hero In You program and explore five themes based on values and success, derived from the stories of select Honoured Members. The Hall of Fame Inductee will deliver a 30-minute talk, with time provided for questions and photographs. The Hall of Fame facilitator will bring a projector, laptop, artifacts (subject to availability), gloves for handling the artifacts, power cords and a camera to document the presentation.

After Your Presentation

We value your feedback and appreciate receiving the completed evaluation forms. Please encourage students to reflect on the Hero In You presentation through continued discussion, artwork or essays and share them with the BC Sports Hall of Fame. Visiting the Hall of Fame also makes for a fun and educational field trip. Whether it is at your school or a visit to the Hall, we look forward to collaborating with you!
